West Sport Fishing operates King Pacific Lodge, a remote, luxury sport fishing lodge located on the along the shoreline of the Great Bear Rainforest, within the territory of the Heiltsuk people. We offer an unparalleled experience for anglers and nature enthusiasts in a pristine wilderness setting. Our lodge provides an escape from the ordinary, where guests can enjoy the stunning beauty of the coast, incredible fishing opportunities, and exceptional hospitality.

Our crew stay on site at the lodge location in Bella Bella, BC for the duration of the operating season, from early June to early September. KPL provides safe, clean, and comfortable staff accommodation. Our dedicated crew chef serves quality meals & snacks. Crew are responsible for their own travel to Bella Bella. Transportation from Bella Bella to the lodge location is provided. Our employees have opportunities to use our boats and equipment to fish and/or explore the coast. We have kayaks available for staff use.

We are seeking a Registered Massage Therapist to join our team. The position start date will be in early June 2025. King Pacific Lodge offers a 60/40 split with 60% going to the RMT. Our guests also typically leave generous gratuities for their treatment. We ask our RMTs to be able to perform up to 6 one-hour treatments per day. Additionally, our RMTs are expected to maintain cleanliness and organization in their work area, perform massage related laundry, maintain the massage schedule, and reconcile each treatment for guest billing purposes. There may be opportunities for additional hourly work not related to RMT practice. If such work is performed, an hourly rate is paid. Although we do ask our crew to work every day of the operating season, KPL recognizes and respects the highly physical nature of an RMT's practice and will work with our RMT to accommodate necessary rest if required.
